¹ Each development will be charged based on the additional time incurred by staff or consultants on plan reviews (water, sewer, storm, SWPPP) needed beyond the standard initial submittal and two (2) resubmittal reviews, until the submittal is approved. For projects involving only CU staff, the time charged will be on the basis of CU review staff time spent. For projects involving staff and consultants, the time charged will be on the basis of the senior consultant review time spent.

These reviews do not include review of a primary vs. review of secondary. Those would each be treated as separate reviews. Projects previously reviewed and/or approved that need an amendment/revision or that have not started construction been idle for 12 months or more since the initial review will require a new submittal and approval prior to starting construction.

² The first SWPPP Inspection shall occur at the beginning of the project prior to construction beginning and that cost is not included in this fee. This fee pays for monthly inspections after construction begins for first 180 days and/or up to a Notice of Termination that occurs in first 180 days. For projects involving only CU staff, the time measurement will be on the basis of CU engineer time spent on the review. For projects involving staff and consultants, the time measurement will be on the basis of the senior consultant engineer review time spent on the review.

³ Sites with an Notice of Violation (NOV) will incur a re-inspection cost calculated as noted in the table per each inspection until the site is brought into compliance. Additional costs for construction improvements/fines that may be incurred will be charged back to the developer.

⁴ All sites will be rounded to the nearest hundreth for purposes of determining permit and SWPPP inspection fees.
