City Utilities has developed and is implementing a Wellhead Protection Plan (WHPP) to help protect groundwater quality in the area around the emergency Honeysuckle drinking water system in northeast Allen County. As a customer (homeowner) an organization interested in protecting groundwater, you are invited to the upcoming annual meeting for the Honeysuckle wellhead protection plan. City utilities' staff members are responsible for implementing best management practices to protect the Honeysuckle wells, identifying, and monitoring potential sources of drinking water contamination in the wellhead protection area, and educating customers, landowners, and leaseholders in the area.

We will host our annual meeting via computer using Zoom video communication. That meeting will be on **November 4, 2025, at 6 p.m.** We hope you will attend and encourage neighbors to join us to learn more about wellhead protection. City Utilities staff members will be available to answer any questions you may have.
